

# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION

BETWEEN

**BURAPHA UNIVERSITY**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is agreed upon and signed at the Burapha University on 9 June 2022. “**Effective Date**” between NTT DATA (Thailand) Co., Ltd. by Mr. Hironari Tomioka as President and Chief Executive Officer, located at 89 Cosmo Office Park Building, 7th Floor, Popular Road, Ban Mai, Pakkret, Nonthaburi 11120. hereafter referred to as “**Corporate**” and Burapha University by Associate Professor Dr. Watcharin Gasaluck as President of Burapha University, located at 169 Long-Hard Bangsaen Road, Saensook, Muang, Chon Buri 20131 hereafter referred to as “**Institute**”.

Both parties have mutually agreed upon the following:

## **1. Objectives of the MOU**

- 1.1 To jointly promote academic cooperation between “Corporate” and “Institute”
- 1.2 To jointly develop cooperation between “Corporate” and “Institute” in recommending and enrolling students from “Institute” in the “Corporate” training during the project based internship and/or during the cooperative education program and/or any bilateral project and/or any project belonging to either “Corporate” or “Institute”
- 1.3 To support students development of knowledge and skills concurrently from experience learning obtained directly through internship and passing on from actual situations. The goal is that the students gain the useful knowledge according to the “Corporate” needs and the labor markets.
- 1.4 To foster collaboration between “Corporate” and “Institute” in order to transform competent students from "Institute" into staffs of “Corporate” through the processes of recruitment and selection. (Selecting students to be staffs depends on judgment and recruitment and selection conditions provided solely by “Corporate”)

## **2. Framework and guidelines for cooperation**

Both parties shall collaborate on the following activities.

- 2.1 “Corporate” and “Institute” are willing to jointly discuss and exchange a variety of relevant academic knowledge.

- 2.2 “Corporate” and “Institute” will jointly collaborate such that students will gain more opportunities in professional training and/or in project-based internship with “Corporate” and/or in the cooperative education program and/or in any bilateral project and/or any project belonging to either “Corporate” or “Institute” (if exists) and will collaborate in various processes in order to achieve effective professional trainings and/or summer internships and conform to the “Corporate” needs and labor markets.
- 2.3 To the benefits of students to learn and practice using actual equipment in “Corporate”, “Corporate” is willing to support equipment to “Institute” as in-class teaching and learning media and instruments as per both parties may have agreed, up on necessity and suitability.
- 2.4 “Institute” may invite staffs from “Corporate” as special lecturers and guest speakers at “Institute”. “Institute” will be responsible for any expense occurring as the result of the invitation “Corporate” staffs becoming special lecturers, except as otherwise agreed in written form.
- 2.5 “Institute” shall collaborate in coordinating, providing, and distributing lists of students who would like to apprentice and/or enroll in “Corporate” (If applicable). “Institute” shall discuss and decide together with “Corporate” in utilizing “Institute” space for activities involving recruiting and selecting students for internship and/or for positions at “Corporate”. In order to achieving the first objective, “Institute” and “Corporate” shall discuss and decide in each occasion on any expense occurring during events holding at “Institute”.

### **3. Initial date and duration of MOU**

- 3.1 This term of MOU will begin on the date of Effective Date and continue in force and effect for a period of three (3) years.
- 3.2 “Corporate” and “Institute” may decide to extend the effective duration of this MOU and this extension must be reached at least 6 months prior to the expiration of the current MOU. However, the extension between “Corporate” and “Institute” must not be longer than three (3) years and current conditions and MOU must be remained, unless otherwise agreed.

### **4. Termination of MOU**

Either party may decide to terminate the MOU provided with rational reasons, giving the other party thirty (30) days written notice providing details and reasons for termination. Both parties may claim for any occurred expense as the result from termination only if agreed upon and written consent by both parties. Both parties shall acknowledge and agree that no claim can be obliged if no written MOU on expense provided prior to termination becomes effective. As the result, both parties agree to waive their right to claim for any damage and loss from termination.

### **5. Modification of MOU**

Any change on this MOU is possible when both parties agree upon and written consent must be provided in the similar manner of this MOU.

### **6. Governing Law and Compliance**

The validity, interpretation and enforceability of this MOU shall be governed by the laws of Thailand. Both parties agrees to strictly comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations whether at present or in the future.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, the Corporate and Institute, intending to be legally bound hereby have, by their duly authorized representatives, executed this MOU in duplicate on the date below each signature, with the intent that this MOU shall be effective as of the Effective Date, and each Party has retained one of the two duplicate originals.


